

## Noble Qur'an (English Translation)

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The **Noble Qur'an**, known as the **Hilali-Khan** translation, is a translation of the Qur'an by Dr. Muhammad Muhsin Khan, and Dr. Muhammad Taqi-ud-Din al-Hilali. This English translation was sponsored by the Saudi government. It is assumed that this is the most popular and "Now the most widely disseminated Qur'an in most Islamic bookstores and Sunni mosques throughout the English-speaking world, this new translation is meant to replace the Yusuf 'Ali edition and comes with a seal of approval from both the University of Medina and the Saudi Dar al-Ifta. This venture utilizes mainstream classical sources of commentaries namely, Tabari, Qurtubi and Ibn Kathir.

## Surah Fajr

(The Dawn)



1.	وَالْفَجْرِ
	By the dawn;
2.	وَلَيَالٍ عَشْرٍ
	By the ten nights.(i.e. the first ten days of the month of Dhul-Hîjjah)
3.	والشَّفْع وَالْوَتُرِ
	And by the even and the odd (of all the creations of Allâh).
4.	وَاللَّيْلِ إِذَا يَسْرِ
	And by the night when it departs.

5.	<u>ۿڶ؋ۣۮٙڸ</u> ڰؘۊؘ؊ۄؓڸڹؚۑڿڋڔٟ
	There is indeed in them (the above oaths) sufficient proofs for men of understanding (and that, they should avoid all kinds of sins and disbeliefs, etc.)!
6.	أَلَمُ تَرَكَيْفَ فَعَلَى اللَّهِ عِادِ
	Did you (O Muhammad SAW) not see (thought) how your Lord dealt with 'Ad (people)?
7.	إِمَّدَ اَتِ الْعِمَادِ
	Who were very tall like lofty pillars,
8.	الَّتِي لَمۡ يُغۡلَقُ مِثۡلُهَا فِي الْبِلَادِ
	The like of which were not created in the land?
9.	وَ ثَمُودَ الَّذِينَ جَابُوا الصَّخْرَ بِالْوَادِ
	And (with) Thamûd (people), who cut (hewed) out rocks in the valley (to make dwellings)?
10.	وَفِرْعَوْنَ ذِي الْأَوْتَادِ
	And (with) Fir'aun (Pharaoh), who had pegs (who used to torture men by binding them to pegs)?
11.	الَّذِينَ طَغَوُ افِي الْبِلَادِ
	Who did transgress beyond bounds in the lands (in the disobedience of Allâh).
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12.	فَأَكْثَرُوافِيهَا الْفَسَادَ
	And made therein much mischief.
13.	فَصَبَّ عَلَيْهِمْ رَبُّلْكَ سَوْطَ عَنَابٍ
	So your Lord poured on them different kinds of severe torment.
14.	إنَّى رَبَّكَ لِبَالْمِرْصَادِ
	Verily, your Lord is Ever Watchful (over them).
15.	فَأَمَّا الْإِنْسَانِ إِذَامَا ابْتَلَاهُ مَبُّهُ فَأَكْرَمَهُ وَنَعَّمَهُ فَيَقُولُ مَنِّي أَكْرَمَن
	As for man, when his Lord tries him by giving him honour and gifts, then he says (puffed up):
	"My Lord has honoured me!"
16.	وَأُمَّا إِذَامَا ابُتَلاهُ فَقَلَىَ عَلَيْهِ مِنْ قَهُ فَيَقُولُ مَ بِيَّ أَهَانَنِ
	But when He tries him, by straitening his means of life, he says:
	"My Lord has humiliated me!"
17.	7/5
	Nay!
	بَلْلاتُكْرِمُونَ الْيَتِيمَ
	But you treat not the orphans with kindness and generosity!
	(i.e. you neither treat them well, nor give them their exact right of inheritance)

18.	وَلا تَحَاضُّونَ عَلَى طَعَامِ الْمِسْكِينِ
	And urge not on the feeding of Al Miskîn (the poor)!
19.	وَتَأْكُلُونَ الثُّرَاكَ أَكُلَّا لِنَّا
	And you devour inheritance all with greed,
20.	وَتُحِبُّونَ الْمَالَ حُبَّا جَمَّا
	And you love wealth with much love!
21.	كَلَّ إِذَا دُكَّتِ الْأَنْصُ دَكًّا دَكًّا
	Nay! When the earth is ground to powder,
22.	وَجَاءَى بُلْكَ وَالْمَلَكُ صَفًّا صَفًّا
	And your Lord comes with the angels in rows,
23.	٠ ۅٙڿؚۑءؘؽۅٛڡۧٸؚ۠ڶٟڮؚۿ <sup>ڹ</sup> ۜٙڝٙ
	And Hell will be brought near that Day.
	يَوْمَئِدٍ يَتَنَكَّرُ الْإِنْسَانُ وَأَنَّى لَهُ الذِّكْرَى
	On that Day will man remember, but how will that remembrance (then) avail him?
24.	يَقُولُ يَالَيْتَنِي قَلَّامُتُ لِيَاتِي
	He will say:
	"Alas! Would that I had sent forth (good deeds) for (this) my life!"

25.	فَيَوْمَئِذٍ لَا يُعَذِّبُ عَنَابَهُ أَحَنَّ
	So on that Day, none will punish as He will punish.
26.	وَلايُوثِنُوتَاقَهُ أَحَدٌ
	And none will bind as He will bind.
27.	يَا أَيَّتُهَا النَّفُسُ الْمُطْمَئِنَّةُ
	(It will be said to the pious):
	"O (you) the one in (complete) rest and satisfaction!
28.	الْيَجِعِي إِلَى مَيِّلْكِ مَ اضِيةً مَرْضِيَّةً
	"Come back to your Lord,
	Well-pleased (yourself) and well-pleasing unto Him!
29.	فَادُخُلِي فِي عِبَادِي
	"Enter you, then, among My honoured slaves,
30.	<u>وَادُجُٰلِي جَنَّتِي</u>
	"And enter you My Paradise!"
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
