

Noble Qur'an (English Translation)

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The **Noble Qur'an**, known as the **Hilali-Khan** translation, is a translation of the Qur'an by Dr. Muhammad Muhsin Khan, and Dr. Muhammad Taqi-ud-Din al-Hilali. This English translation was sponsored by the Saudi government. It is assumed that this is the most popular and "Now the most widely disseminated Qur'an in most Islamic bookstores and Sunni mosques throughout the English-speaking world, this new translation is meant to replace the Yusuf 'Ali edition and comes with a seal of approval from both the University of Medina and the Saudi Dar al-Ifta. This venture utilizes mainstream classical sources of commentaries namely, Tabari, Qurtubi and Ibn Kathir.

	And by the sun and its brightness;
2.	And by the moon as it follows it (the sun);
	And by the day as it shows up (the sun's) brightness;
4.	And by the night as it conceals it (the sun);
5.	And by the heaven and Him Who built it;
6.	And by the earth and Him Who spread it,
	And by Nafs (Adam or a person or a soul, etc.), and Him Who perfected him in proportion;
8.	Then He showed him what is wrong for him and what is right for him;

	(i.e. obeys and performs all that Allâh ordered, by following the true Faith of Islâmic Monotheism and by doing righteous good deeds).

	(i.e. disobeys what Allâh has ordered by rejecting the true Faith of Islâmic Monotheism or by following
	polytheism, etc. or by doing every kind of evil wicked deeds).
11.	Thamûd (people) denied (their Prophet) through their transgression
	(by rejecting the true Faith of Islâmic Monotheism, and by following polytheism, and by committing every
	kind of sin).
12.	When the most wicked man among them went forth (to kill the she-camel).
13.	But the Messenger of Allâh [Sâlih (Saleh)] said to them:
	"Be cautious! Fear the evil end. That is the she-camel of Allâh! (Do not harm it) and bar it not from having its
	drink!"
14.	Then they denied him and they killed it.
	So their Lord destroyed them because of their sin, and made them equal in destruction!
	(i.e. all grades of people, rich and poor, strong and weak, etc.)

15.	And He (Allâh) feared not the consequences thereof.



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
