	And those Foremost (in Faith) will be Foremost (in the Hereafter).
11.	أُولَيِكَ ٱلْمُقَرَّبُونَ
	These will be those Nearest to Allah:
12.	فيجتنت التعيم
	In Gardens of Bliss:
13.	ثُلَّةٌ مِّنَ ٱلْأَوَّلِينَ
	A number of people from those of old,
14.	وَقَلِيلٌ مِّنَ ٱلْأَخِرِينَ
	And a few from those of later times.
15.	عَلَىٰسُرُسٍمِّوۡضُونَةٍ
	(They will be) on Thrones encrusted (with gold and precious stones).

16.	مُّتَّكِينَ عَلَيْهَا مُتَقَبِلِينَ
	Reclining on them, facing each other.
<u>17.</u>	يَطُوفُ عَلَيْهِمْ وِلْدَانٌ شُّحَلَّدُونَ
	Round about them will (serve) youths of perpetual (freshness).
18.	بِأَكُوابٍوأَبَارِينَوكَأُسٍمِّن مَّعِينٍ
	With goblets, (shining) beakers, and cups (filled) out of clear-flowing fountains:

	No after-ache will they receive therefrom, nor will they suffer intoxication:

	Like unto Pearls well-guarded.

	A Reward for the Deeds of their past (Life).
25.	لايسمعون فيها لغُوًا وَلا تَأْثِيمًا
	No frivolity will they hear therein nor any taint of ill

	Only the saying, "Peace! Peace."

	In shade long-extended,
31.	وَمَآءٍ مِّسْكُوبٍ
	By water flowing constantly,
32.	وَفَكِهَةٍ كَثِيرَةٍ
	And fruit in abundance,
33.	لَّامَقُطُوعَةٍ وَلَا لَمَنُوعَةٍ
	Whose season is not limited nor (supply) forbidden,
34.	وَفُرُشٍ مَّرُفُوعَةٍ
	And on Thrones (of Dignity), raised high.

	A (goodly) number from those of old,
40.	وَثُلَّةٌ مِّنَ ٱلْأَخِرِينَ
	And a (goodly) number from those of later times.
41.	وَأَصْحَبُ ٱلشِّمَالِمَا أَصْحَبُ ٱلشِّمَالِ
	The Companions of the Left Handwhat will be the Companions of the Left Hand?
42.	فِيسَمُومٍ وَتَحْمِيمٍ
	(They will be) in the midst of a fierce Blast of Fire and in Boiling Water,
43.	وَظِلٍّ مِّن يَحْمُومٍ
	And in the shades of Black Smoke:

	Nothing (will there be) to refresh, nor to please:

	"Indeed ye shall drink like diseased camels raging with thirst!
56.	هَنَانُرُهُمُ يَوْمَ ٱلدِّينِ
	Such will be their entertainment on the Day of Requital!
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57.	نُحُنُ خَلَقُنَا كُمْ فَلَوْلا تُصَدِّقُونَ
	It is We Who have created you: why will ye not witness the Truth?
58.	أَفَرَ ءَيْتُم مَّا جُمُنُونَ
	Do ye then see? the (human seed) that ye throw out,

	Is it ye who create it, or are We the Creators?

	We have decreed Death to be your common lot, and We are not to be frustrated

	From changing your Forms and creating you (again) in (Forms) that ye know not.
	Trom shanging your rolling and creating you (again) in (1 offis) that ye know hot.

	And ye certainly know already the first form of creation: why then do ye not celebrate His praises?

	See ye the seed that ye sow in the ground?
64.	عَأَنتُمْ تَزْيَعُونَكُ أَمْ نَعْنُ ٱلزَّابِعُونَ
	Is it ye that cause it to grow, or are We the Cause?
65.	لَوْنَشَاء جَعَلْنَه حُطَمًا فَظَلْتُمْ تَفَكَّهُونَ
	Were it Our Will, we could crumble it to dry powder, and ye would be left in wonderment,
66.	إِنَّا لَهُغُرَمُونَ
	(Saying), "We are indeed left with debts (for nothing):
67.	بَلْ نَحْنُ مَحْرُومُونَ
	"Indeed are we shut out (of the fruits of our labor)."
68.	أَفَرَءَيُتُمُ ٱلْمَاءَ ٱلَّذِي تَشُرَبُونَ
	See ye the water which ye drink?
69.	ءَأَنتُمُ أَنزَلْتُمُوهُمِنَ ٱلْمُزُنِ أَمُ نَحُنُ ٱلْمُنزِلُونَ
	Do ye bring it Down (in rain) from the Cloud, or do We?
70.	لَوْنَشَآءُ جَعَلْنَهُ أُجَاجًا فَلُوْلا تَشُكُرُونَ
	Were it Our Will, We could make it salt (and unpalatable): then why do ye not give thanks?
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71.	أَفَرَءَيْتُمُ ٱلنَّامَ ٱلَّتِي تُومُونَ
	See ye the Fire which ye kindle?
72.	ءَأَنتُمُ أَنشَأُتُمُ شَجَرَتَهَا أَمُ نَحُنُ ٱلْمُنشُونَ
	Is it ye who grow the tree which feeds the fire, or do We grow it?
73.	نَحُنُ جَعَلْنَهَا تَنْ كِرَةً وَمَتَعًا لِلْمُقُويِنَ
	We have made it a memorial (of our handiwork), and an article of comfort and convenience for the denizens of deserts.
74.	فَسَبِّحُ بِأَسُورِ مَ بِبِكَ ٱلْعَظِيمِ
	Then celebrate with praises the name of the Lord, the Supreme:
75.	فَلَا أُقْسِمُ بِمَوَا قِعِ ٱلنُّجُومِ
	Furthermore I call to witness the setting of the Stars
76.	وَإِنَّهُ لَقَسَمٌ لَّوْ تَعْلَمُونَ عَظِيمٌ
	And that is indeed a mighty adjuration if ye but knew
77.	إِنَّهُ لَقُرْءَانٌ كَرِيمٌ
	That this is indeed a Qur'an most honorable,
78.	في كِتَبٍمَّكُنُونِ
	In a Book well-guarded,
79.	لَّا يَمَسُّهُ إِلَّا ٱلْمُطَهَّرُونَ
	Which none shall touch but those who are clean:

80.	تَنزِيلٌ مِّن رَّبِٱلْحَامِين
	A Revelation from the Lord of the Worlds.
81.	أَفَهَا لَا لَكِيثِ أَنتُم مُّكُهِنُونَ
	Is it such a Message that ye would hold in light esteem?
82.	وَتَجْعَلُونَ بِرِزْقَكُمُ أَنَّكُمُ تُكَنِّبُونَ
	And have ye made it your livelihood that ye should declare it false?

83.	فَلَوْلًا إِذَا بَلَغَتِ ٱلْحُلُقُومَ
	Then why do ye not (intervene) when (the soul of the dying man) reaches the throat
84.	وَأَنتُمْ حِينَإِنَ تَنظُرُونَ
	And ye the while (sit) looking on
85.	وَنَحُنُ أَقُرَبِ إِلَيْهِ مِنكُمْ وَلَكِن لِآتُبُصِرُونَ
	But We are nearer to him than ye, and yet see not
86.	فَلَوۡلَا إِن كُنتُمۡ غَيۡر مَدِينِين
	Then why do you not if you are exempt from (future) account
87.	تَرْجِعُونَهَا إِن كُنتُمْ صَدِقِينَ
	Call back the soul, if ye are true (in your claim of Independence)?
88.	فَأَمَّا إِن كَانَ مِنَ ٱلْمُقَرَّبِينَ
	Thus, then, if he be of those Nearest to Allah,

89.	فَرَوْحٌ وَرَيْحَانٌ وَجَنَّتُ نَعِيمٍ
	(There is for him) Rest and Satisfaction, and a Garden of Delights.
90.	وَأَمَّا إِن كَانَ مِنْ أَصْحَبِ ٱلْيَحِينِ
	And if he be of the Companions of the Right Hand,
91.	فَسَلَمٌ لَكَ مِنُ أَصْحَبِ ٱلْيَمِينِ
	(For him is the salutation), "Peace be unto thee," from the Companions of the Right Hand.
92.	وَأُمَّا إِن كَانَ مِنَ ٱلْمُكَذِّبِينَ ٱلضَّالِّينَ
	And if he be of those who treat (truth) as Falsehood, who go wrong,

	For him is Entertainment with Boiling Water.
94.	وتَصْلِيةُ جَحِيمٍ
	And burning in Hell-fire.
95.	إِنَّ هَنَا لَهُ وَحَتُّ ٱلْيَقِينِ
	Verily, this is the Very Truth and Certainty.
96.	فَسَبِّحُ بِٱلْسَوِى آلِيَاكَ ٱلْعَظِيمِ
	So celebrate with praises the name of thy Lord, the Supreme.
